

2010 AIA KENTUCKY SPECIAL AWARDS

Special Awards For Outstanding Service to the Profession Nomination Deadline July 9, 2010

THE PROGRAM

The presidents of the three local AIA Chapters in Kentucky are now accepting nominations for 2010 AIA Kentucky Special Awards. All members of AIA Kentucky are encouraged to give consideration to individuals and firms, both within the profession and without, who merit recognition for their accomplishments on behalf of the architectural profession. Nominations for each award category must be made, in writing, to one of the Chapter Presidents no later than **Friday, July 9, 2010**.

Each chapter will consider all nominations received and then recommend a slate of nominees for consideration by the AIA Kentucky Special Awards Committee. The chapter president and one other representative of each local chapter serve on the committee. All awards may be presented or not presented at the discretion of the Special Awards Committee.

THE AWARDS

C. Julian Oberwarth Award

To recognize and honor an individual Member who has displayed a long-standing commitment to the betterment of the profession and well-being of architects in Kentucky, and who has dedicated extraordinary time and talent to this end.

THE AWARDS

Distinguished Service Award

To honor an individual Member for a specific contribution or for their dedication and service which has significantly furthered the purposes of AIA Kentucky.

Distinguished Firm Award

To recognize a Member Firm which, through consistent leadership, vision and ability, has distinguished itself over the past decade through design and implementation of works of architecture that enhance the quality of our environment.

Honorary Membership

To honor an individual not otherwise eligible for membership who, with unselfish energy and support, has made a significant contribution to forwarding the goals of AIA Kentucky.

John Russell Groves

Citizens Laureate Award

To honor an individual and advocate who has consistently supported and encouraged the values of quality architecture in their community through leadership, service and dedication to a better living environment.

Emerging Professional Award

To recognize an individual Associate AIA member or an AIA Architect member who has been registered 10 years or less who exemplifies the highest qualities of leadership and who has demonstrated an unparalleled commitment to their AIA component or region, to the design and construction industry, to the community, and/or to other professional organizations.

Allied Professional Award

To pay tribute to an individual or firm directly involved in the A/E/C industry which has constantly endeavored to work harmoniously with architects and other allied professionals toward the implementation of creative and innovative design solutions.

NOMINATIONS

Complete the nomination form and mail with accompanying documentation to the president of the chapter of which the nominee is a member. In the case of non-members, mail to the chapter which is nearest to the nominee's home/business.

Each chapter will evaluate all nominations it receives and forward recommendations in any or all award categories to the Special Awards Committee for consideration.

The Committee will consider the chapter nominations and recommend award recipients to the AIA Kentucky Board of Directors for acceptance. The awards will be presented at the AIA Kentucky/AIA Indiana Convention at Belterra Casino Resort & Spa on Friday, October 15, 2010.
